All papers will be subjected to a peer-review process. Submitted papers should not have been previously published or be currently under consideration for publication elsewhere.

BACKGROUND CONTEXT FOR THIS ISSUE:

The KwaZulu-Natal province is challenged by the fiscal drain and increased budget constraints that have been worsened by social unrest, floods, COVID19 and other issues. Government is exploring possible ways of creating the public wealth fund. Therefore, we are asking for authors to submit papers providing possible practical solutions.

RESEARCH PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- The MKI journal only accepts research papers that are written in English.
- Authors are encouraged to exercise their freedom of expression and maintain research autonomy.
- The language and content of articles should be free from sexist, racial and ethnic slurs.
- Authors are encouraged to use gender-inclusive language e.g., humankind, instead of men.
- The MKI journal is an open-access journal that is accessible through online registration.
- Submit an abstract of the paper (250 words) explaining your paper project, your research question, your methodology, significance of your paper, summary of your results and how your paper fits with the research theme. Due date for the abstract is **16 January 2023**
- Full paper must not exceed 8000 words and should be submitted by **31 January 2023**
- Successful authors will be expected to present their papers at the KZN Research Conference in Durban on 2-3 March 2023. Once the presentation has been delivered, successful authors will receive compensation in recognition of their time.
